1. General Knowledge (G.K.) will be assessed twice a year for 50 marks each ( $50 \times 2 = 100$ ).
2. Computer will be assessed on the basis of practicals ( $2 \times 15 = 30$ ) and written assessments ( $2 \times 10 = 20$ ) in each term for 50 marks each ( $50 \times 2 = 100$ ).
