Assessment includes:

❖ **Internal Assessment**

- (a) Multiple Assessment – Strategies to be used are quizzes, oral tests, concept maps, visual expression etc.
- (b) Portfolio – Classwork, peer assessment, self - assessment, achievements of student in the subject, reflections, narrations, journals, etc. will be assessed.
- (c) Subject Enrichment Activities –
Languages – Speaking and Listening Skills, Mathematics – Lab Activities, Science – Practical Work, Social Science – Project Work (Art Integration), Skill Subjects – Lab Practical / Activities and file.

❖ **Periodic Tests** – Three Periodic Tests will be taken and the average of the best two shall be considered in the Final Examination.

❖ **Class Tests** – Class tests will be conducted by the subject teachers in their regular periods.
