Both communist and socialist ideologies stem from a common goal of abolishing class disparities between the rich and the poor. Karl Marx, the most popular critic of a capitalistic society, primarily laid the foundation of these ideologies and through Karl Marx's perception of a classless, moneyless and a stateless society, emerged new faces of communism including Vladimir Lenin, Mao Zedong, Joseph Stalin and many more. His theories centred around the idea that in a capitalistic society, workers are often exploited by those who owned the means of production. Marxism theory advocates for a society where the labourers and workers collectively own and control their means of production. In this ideology, every person gets only a fixed amount of money on the basis of their work to fulfil their basic requirements. Throughout history, Marx's theory, although faced by many


