

The Indian National Army (INA), also known as the Azad Hind Fauj, was an armed force formed by Indian nationalists under the patronage of the Imperial Japanese Army to secure India's independence. Now let's learn about one of the bravest of the brave, Jemadar Nand Singh, who showed unfaltering leadership and courage to accomplish the mission.

During World War II, an acting Naik participated in operations against the Japanese in Burma. He led his troops up a very dangerous, steep ridge and captured major trenches, despite carrying multiple injuries. Amidst heavy firing and losing many of his men, he single-handedly managed to recapture the three Japanese-held trenches. He displayed indomitable courage and determination without caring about his life. He was recognised

with Britain's highest honour, the Victoria Cross.

Nand Singh rose to the rank of Jemadar in the post-independence Indian Army. On December 12, 1947, he helped extricate his battalion from a Pakistani ambush in the hills south-east of Uri in Kashmir. He was killed in this action and posthumously awarded the Maha Vir Chakra (MVC), the second-highest Indian decoration for battlefield gallantry. Unfortunately, his mortal remains could not be recovered as he was taken away by the enemies.

Our motherland is a land of kshatriyas-brave warriors. There are many bravehearts who have given their lives for our country, but no one knows about them, their stories, or their supreme sacrifices. The spirit of India is incomplete unless and until we recall and pay respect to our forgotten heroes. We should never let their contributions fade into oblivion.

ChatGPT and its Origins

ChatGPT is an AI Chatbot that was released on 30 November, 2022. It is developed by OpenAI, an American AI Research Laboratory co-founded by a lot of people including Sam Altman and Elon Musk.

Here, 'Chat' refers to it being a chatbot and 'GPT' to Generative Pre-trained Transformer, which is a type of Large Language Model.

A few General uses of ChatGPT are as follows :-

A few drawbacks of ChatGPT on education are as follows :-

- (i) Accuracy - As it generates information from the web, it always may not be factual.
- (ii) Dependent on Technology - It's dependent on the availability of technology.
- (iii) Certain Biases - It may catch upon certain articles which may be biased or contradict your ideas.
- (iv) Human Connect - However it may improve, ChatGPT can never fully replicate the conversation between two persons, however it may improve.
