

The Annual Report 2018-19 showcases the achievements and progress of the school. The School has always been committed to create an environment which facilitates the young minds to blossom and provide a platform for individual thinking and holistic development of the child's personality.

As a regular practice followed every year, this session began with the Orientation Programme for the parents and students of Middle and Senior classes. The programme made them aware of the scheme of evaluation as per CBSE guidelines.

The school introduced Legal Studies, Political Science and Commercial Arts in 2018 and our first batch of class XII with these subjects have appeared for AISSCE in 2019. Vocational Course "Information Technology" has been introduced as a compulsory subject in class IX in the session 2018-19.

107 candidates were enrolled for All India Secondary School Examination (Class X) and the pass percentage was 99.07. Certificate of Merit awarded for outstanding academic performance and for being among the top 0.1 percent of successful candidates in Social Science (1 student). Two students Qualified KVPY Stage 1

66 candidates were enrolled for All India Secondary School Certificate Examination (Class XII) and the pass percentage was 100. Certificate of Merit awarded for outstanding academic performance and for being among the top 0.1 percent of successful candidates in Economics (2 students), Painting (2 students) and Psychology (1 student).

Students have participated in various Olympiads, namely, Science, Mathematics, English, Computer, French etc. and have bagged trophies and medals. Their achievements are made available for the parents and students on the Facebook page of the school.

Students are given ample opportunities to participate in inter-house, inter-class, inter-school activities related to environment conservation. Key features are tree plantation, hand-on-experience, agricultural visits, interactive sessions with profession experts, cleanliness drive, assemblies hanging *parindas* for birds, exhibitions, compost pit in school premises for bio-degradable wastes, rain water harvesting etc.

Parents have a direct access to communicate with me and the class teacher for regular updates of their child. The cases which need my personal attention are escalated directly to me through E-mails.
