V. ACTIVITIES

❖ **CBSE ACTIVITIES**

1) **Har Ghar Tiranga**: The event was organised from 13th August 2022 to 15th August 2022 from Pre-Primary upto the Senior Secondary Classes. Director Princess Diya Kumari ji visited the school to create awareness for Har Ghar Tiranga campaign. She addressed the parents & the students. To mark this momentous occasion our young leaders participated enthusiastically in the sing-along activity.

Students participated in a parade, which culminated in the formation of number 75 on the sports field.

2) **Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav**: To commemorate the 75th Anniversary of India's independence, the school organised various activities for the students of classes VI-VIII including discussions by teachers in class to make children aware about how a nation is build and lectures by teachers about the freedom struggle. Activities like Slogan Writing, Poster Making, Story Telling, Poem Recitation, and Group Discussions pertaining to the events, people and places who contributed to India's freedom struggle allowed the students to show their love and respect for the nation. Declamation Contest regarding historical events and places during

India's freedom struggle movement not only helped the students in developing confidence in public speaking but also spread awareness amongst the enthusiastic audience.

- 4) **Swachhata Pakhwada:** Activities were conducted in school to focus on the issues and practices of cleanliness. Activities like Quiz based on Covid safe, clean and well-maintained school premises and Slogan Writing were conducted. A video presentation was shown to create awareness among the students about the right and wrong practices followed by people. Students from Pre-Primary to Senior Secondary also took a Swachhata pledge assuring to maintain cleanliness and hygiene.
Hands Hygiene Activity: Practicing experiential learning, the students of Bubbles (Pre-Primary Section) learnt the importance of washing hands with soap.

The activity helped the students to know about the Gallantry award winners and their sacrifice for the nation.
- 7) **Reading Challenge 2022-23:** To promote reading literacy, CBSE launched a Reading Challenge for the students of classes VI to X. Online quizzes were conducted for the students of class VI – VII, VIII – X in Level 1. In Level 2, top 2 achievers from each grade appeared for the online quiz. Multiple activities were conducted for the students of Pre-Primary to Class V to promote reading literacy.
- 8) **Observance of International Women's Day :** To celebrate the achievements of women and mark a call to action for gender equality, the students of Classes I to V observed International Women's Day on 4th March, 2023. - Regular training sessions and workshops on advanced 21st century skills such as Robotics, Artificial Intelligence, 3D printing, Aero modelling etc. for enhanced learning.
- Hands on Training Sessions for Teachers on Waste Segregation and Compost making.

- Launch of Sustainable Development and Zero Waste Programme in collaboration with Dr. B.Lal Institute of Biotechnology, Prakrit (Sustainable Integrated Foundation) and Ecowrap (Waste Management Enterprise).
- Celebration of Community Week with students of neighbouring NGOs and non ATL schools.
- MSBSS students participated in the Financial Literacy Programme organised by Wealth Vidya under which they attended 3 days online workshop and prepared projects on the topics such as :

- Buy Now Pay Later Scheme
- Credit Score and College Planning
- How does Zomato and Ola make Money
- Life Insurance
- Digital Assets and NFT

Projects of our 28 commerce wizards have been selected among all participants across India and they will appear for the final round of Inter-Finance Competition.

- 5) Pre-Primary Teachers conducted a session "This Is How We Learn" for parents wherein they shared effective ideas and activities with parents to keep the children constructively engaged at home.
- 6) An International Level LEAD Company of the Year Competition was organized by tGELF in which students of class IX and XII participated. Class IX students were among the top 12 finalist. The students made sustainable, eco-friendly and affordable jewellery from clay. They floated a company CLAILEA and learnt how to sell a product as real companies do in business.
- 7) LEARN to EARN activity was conducted by Class XI Entrepreneurship students in which they sold handmade items like soaps, chocolates, book covers etc.
- 8) Design Thinking and Innovation: The school implemented DT&I curriculum for Class VI students from November 2022 onwards for the academic session 2022-23. The students were engaged in various activities as mentioned in the modules to develop critical thinking. They actively participated in puppet making, story narration, exploring form transitions and forms in environment. The students also learnt to sketch their ideas that helped them in giving a visual representation to their thoughts or give a concrete shape to the solution of the problem.
- 9) Project Haunsla - Short Story Writing: Students participated in Project Haunsla and wrote short stories on 'Paraplegic' people. The first phase included identifying such people who have achieved success beating against all odds and now are a source of inspiration for others. The next step was meeting these people and talking to them. The second phase was 8 days of Intensive Writing Workshop organized by the school. Under the guidance of Ms. Shubha Menon, an experienced writing coach and author, the students learned various writing styles, story building, portrayal of characters, etc. and turned their factual accounts into interesting stories, which will inspire students of the school. Students who participated were Anoushka Garg, Arshiya Midha, Anushri Roy, Adaa, Ayushi Bhagwani, Anika Pareek, Riddhika Godwal, Vedika Gulati and Vamika Singh.

10) tGELF Sessions - To nurture 21st century leadership and entrepreneurship skills based on ethics, altruism, and a base for action in the students, various tGELF sessions were conducted for the students of classes VI-VIII throughout the session. Students exhibited exceptional leadership qualities and made a commitment to be fair and responsible leaders. tGELF sessions were conducted in Classes IX and X through Modules provided by the NGO with an aim to strengthen and build leadership qualities among students. The modules focused on identifying leadership qualities and characteristics of good leaders, teamwork and effective communication skills. The sessions were interactive with students actively participating in the discussion.
